Component	Description of Content	# Required Entries
Austen's Life	Biographical details including birth, death, major life events (proposals, travel, illness, death of family members, moves, etc.)	1-2
Austen's Work	Details related to the writing or publishing of each of her four novels: <i>Sense and Sensibility</i> , <i>Pride and Prejudice</i> , <i>Mansfield Park</i> , <i>Persuasion</i>	4-6 (1 for each novel minimum)

Maps: *Components, Descriptions of Content, and # of Required Entries per Person*

Component	Description of Content	# Required Entries
<i>Sense and Sensibility</i>	Locations actual and fictional included in the plot and setting of the novel. Please indicate if a location is fictional in () and include descriptions of each location's relevance to the story. Include relevant pictures with your entries.	2-3
